- 1. The Norms/conditions mentioned in the Affiliation Order of the respective colleges shall be adhered.
- The colleges shall submit the applications for issue of Eligibility certificate in respect of foreign Nationals before 15.11.2021 The applications received after this date will not be considered.
- 3. The last date for obtaining permission from university for admission to 3rd semester on transfer from other colleges/ universities and re-admission to 3rd semester before **27.09.2021**

- 4. Principals are directed to forward the representations of the students seeking permission for transfer admission along with No Due Certificate, No Objection Certificate, Migration certificate and photo copies of previous semester marks card to the University.
- 5. Principals are directed to make admissions strictly in accordance with the Eligibility condition and also as per the sanction intake for each course.
- 6. The Principals should consider the marks cards of the qualifying exams of the recognized Boards only. The list of recognized Boards is available in the University Website i.e., <u>www.bcu.ac.in</u>. Any marks card other than notified shall not be considered.
- The students who have passed 2nd year PUC Examination from Karnataka Pre-University Board, Govt. of Karnataka are eligible to take admissions to Under Graduate Degree Courses.
- 8. The students who have passed (10+2) Examination conducted by Nationals Institute of Opening Schooling is eligible for admissions to Under Graduate Courses with the approval of the University.
- Regulations Governing the NEP-2020 in the Under Graduate Courses in the Faculties of Arts, Science and Commerce shall be followed.
- 10. Principals are directed to allot the invigilation work to the teaching of major subjects such as Commerce, Management, English, Mathematics, Economics, etc., in the beginning of the theory examination and relieve them immediately for evaluation work.
- 11. Principals are further directed to compulsorily collect the evaluation attendance certificate from all the teachers who attended evaluation work in different subjects and produce them before the Local Inquiry Committee for verification at the time of visit.
- 12. During vacation, it is mandatory for teachers to undertake theory valuation and practical examination related work assigned by the University BOE Chairman, otherwise disciplinary action will be initiated for dereliction of duty, in the case of University, Government, and Aided College teachers and in the case of Unaided colleges attending to the examination work are one of the conditions to continue Affiliation.
- 13. Submission of any required document after the sate of approval will not be considered for approval.
- 14. Wherever Bio-Metric attendance is implemented, the principals are directed to take permission from the Higher Authorities to waive the requirement of attendance of the teachers on the days of the examination related work in the University especially during the evaluation of answer books.
- 15. The colleges have to collect and remit the fee as prescribed by the University is in the website: <u>www.bcu.ac.in</u>

16. The Principals are directed to adhere to the above schedule of Calendar of Events and follow the Rules and Regulations strictly.
